Dear Honourable Niki Sharma,

I am deeply concerned about the ongoing criminalization and the criminal charges against Indigenous Wet'suwet'en land defenders who were resisting the construction of the Coastal GasLink (CGL) pipeline through their ancestral, unceded territory without their free, prior and informed consent.

For years they have experienced intimidation, harassment, discrimination and the eviction from their land by the Canadian police (RCMP) and security forces of CGL. Their forests, waters, biodiversity and sacred sites have been damaged and their Indigenous rights violated.

I ask you to ensure that

- the criminal contempt charges against the land defenders and their supporters are dropped immediately,
- harassment, intimidation, unlawful surveillance and criminalization are stopped.
