The *Public Climate School* (PCS) is a space for education, dialogue and interdisciplinary exchange focusing on the climate crisis. Organized by *Climate Law in International Context* (CLIC), the PCS in Hamburg will take place from Tuesday, May 20 to Thursday, May 22, 2025.

Over the course of three days, the PCS will feature panels, lectures, workshops, cultural events and open conversations. Together, we aim to explore the past, present and future of the climate crisis through a justice-centred lens.

What is CLIC?

CLIC is a transnational and interdisciplinary program between the Universities of Chile and Hamburg in the field of climate change and environmental protection, connecting teaching, research and practice. Our goal is to bring together academic, legal and societal perspectives on climate justice, drawing particular attention to North–South dynamics.
